After that we hope to visit the churches that supports our ministry here in Brazil. Please pray that the transplant will be soon!

In our churches we have continued on with Bible studies, evangelism and the preaching of God's word. Sister Fatima goes souls winning in the hospital here in our city of Canoas with up until now more than 200 have been saved. Brother Joel continues on with the ministry of evangelism and preaching in the prison where there are more than 4,000 inmates. This is dangerous because the prison capacity is only 2000 inmates!

In November or the first of December 6 or 8 students will graduate from our Bible Institute. We are grateful to God for these who are interested in becoming teachers and pastors. Thank the Lord!

In the name of Jesus Christ, we are thankful for your prayers and financial help without which it would be very difficult to carry on the work here in southern Brazil.
