## 2018 – Year end report

Dear Coworkers in the cause of Christ,

We hope that this letter finds you in health and enjoying the blessings of our Lord Jesus Christ.

The work of evangelizing in Mozambique, along with training and helping the churches to grow continues to expand. We find that is easy to get folks to come to church but harder for them to understand salvation and trust Christ as their Savior. Nevertheless, we preach Christ and teach the Scriptures to all who will listen. Please pray for our literature campaign and personal work.

In November, we had seven men in the Bible Institute for four weeks of training. These men were a blessing. Our twice a week studies with the young men took a break for a while and we have yet to be able to motivate them to come back. I made one trip to Mutondo but we were somewhat hindered during the present month by flood waters in the area that kept me from getting in to the church.

Both of us have health issues that, so far, we have not able to resolve locally. We are seeking other options for treatment that would allow us to continue in the work of the churches in Mozambique. I mention this solely as a prayer request. Our desire is to be able to continue this work until we see another missionary family come and be established to help the churches here in Mozambique.

During the rainy months of January and February, we hope to do some needed maintenance on the building in Dondo; concrete, tiling, painting and some electrical work are all on the list. We have made a lot of progress on the building project in Gondola as they are doing the final preparing to put their roof on building. Our congregation in Chimoio has finally arranged property and we hope to be beginning the work of the chapel building by the end of March, after the heavier rain. The building project in Mutarara, in the Zambezia Province is awaiting final approval on the land so we hope to begin there also by the end of March. We have received several large offerings toward the finishing of these buildings; we would like to specifically thank Jack and Diane Criswell of Ohio, the Southpoint Baptist Church in Jacksonville, FL and Fellowship Baptist Church in Canton, OH for contributing to this need.

Please pray for our national workers, pastors, and students in the Bible Institute and the congregations and churches that they lead and in which they work. There are many challenges, but God is working, and He is greater than any problem we have.

Thank you for praying for us and supporting the work of God in Mozambique, Africa.
